OBLIGATIONS TO THE SCHOOL AND STUDENTS

Dress Code:

Students must adhere to the prescribed dress code for each class. Proper dance attire and footwear are essential. Hair should be tied back neatly and secured.

Uniforms may be purchased from DANCE STUDY, KAPPARA HILL, SAN GWANN.

Respect and Behaviour:

Students must treat instructors, fellow students, and staff with respect and courtesy at all times.

Disruptive behaviour, offensive language, or any form of bullying will not be tolerated.

Health and Well-being:

The M.J.Bellia Ballet School has a responsibility to ensure the Health and Safety of its members and students and therefore has a duty to provide a working environment that is safe and with minimum risk, promoting safe working procedures, good working conditions and training/instruction suitable for the age and level of the students.

Students should be in good health to participate in classes. Illnesses or injuries should be communicated to the school. Adequate hydration and nutrition are important for sustained energy during classes.

Parents/guardians should promptly inform the school of extended absences or health-related concerns. Maintaining open communication helps instructors make necessary adjustments and accommodations.

Communication:

Parents/guardians should provide accurate contact information. Changes in contact details must be promptly communicated particularly in case we need to contact you in case of emergency.

The school will in turn, communicate important information through official channels such as emails and individual class chats for daily matters. Parents/students should stay informed.

Fees and Payments:

Fees are payable in advance ideally prior to the commencement of the term but not later than the second week from the start of the term. Practice outside of class to reinforce techniques and routines learned in sessions. Arrive prepared for class with necessary attire, footwear, and a positive attitude.
